



CALL FOR SELECTION OF STUDENTS TO STUDY FOR ONE SEMESTER AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MÁLAGA (SPAIN), WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF ERASMUS+ KA171.

The National School of Architecture in Agadir and the University of Málaga (Spain), agreed to cooperate on the exchange of students and staff in the context of the Erasmus+ KA171 program.

To whom: Students of the National School of Architecture in Agadir,

Where to: the University of Málaga (UMA),

Period of the mobility: the First semester of the 2025/26 academic year,

What: The selected students will study 30 credit hours in the study program "BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN FUNDAMENTALS OF ARCHITECTURE" at the School of Architecture of UMA.

Eligible students:

Students from de the National School of Architecture in Agadir currently enrolled in the **third** year.

The financial aid includes:

- Individual support for students: The amount is 850 € per month of activity. Additionally, if applicable for students facing fewer opportunities, an additional amount of 250 € per month is provided.
- Additional support for travel expenses: This amount is calculated based on the following distance bands: https://erasmus-plus.ec.europa.eu/resources-and-tools/distance-calculator

Evaluation Criteria:

- Academic requirements: Grades above average-higher than 8 on a 1/10 scale : 1 point
 Overall academic performance : 1-5 points
 - Spanish certificate (B2/C1 or higher level)

B1: 1 point B2: 1.5 points

C1 or C2: 2 points





English language certificate.

B1: 1 point B2: 1.5 points C1 or C2: 2 points

Applicants with previous collaboration with UMA: 1-3 points

 Participants from disadvantaged backgrounds and with fewer opportunities will get 2 points.

• Inclusion : 1-7 points

The application should contain:

- 1. Academic record.
- 2. Proof of registration
- 3. Personal CV in English.
- 4. Language certificate: Spanish and/or English B2 or higher
- 5. Motivation letter where the applicant expresses the reasons why she/he wishes to participate in this exchange.
- 6. Proposed Learning Agreement
- 7. Scanned passport/ID

Please note that the application will only be considered complete when all the required documents are submitted. All documents must be uploaded in PDF format and the name of the participant must be included in the file's name.

Participants from disadvantaged backgrounds and with fewer opportunities:

Candidates from disadvantaged backgrounds, with special needs, or disabilities are encouraged to apply. They may receive additional funding according to EU regulations to cover costs directly related to their participation in the mobility.

Candidates with a disadvantaged profile, should send with their application supporting documents and official certificates that justify the student's condition

In accordance with the priorities of the Erasmus+ Program, students in any of the following circumstances can be considered from disadvantaged backgrounds.

- 1. Students with a scholarship from the Ministry of Education of their country or equivalent official educational organization.
- 2. Be a large family member, according to the recognition of the country of origin.
- 3. Be a member of a single parent family
- 4. Have a disability more significant than 33% officially recognized in the country of origin or residence.





- 5. Have refugee status in the country of residence.
- 6. Risk of social exclusion or social emergency
- 7. Be an orphan
- 8. Students working full time
