## Eligible students:

Students from de the National School of Architecture in Agadir currently enrolled in the third year.

Participants from disadvantaged backgrounds and with fewer opportunities:







Candidates from disadvantaged backgrounds, including those with special needs or disabilities, are strongly encouraged to apply. Priority will be given to candidates from disadvantaged backgrounds for one of the available mobility places.

Eligible candidates may also receive additional financial support, in line with EU regulations, to help cover expenses directly related to their participation in the mobility program.

Applicants with a disadvantaged profile must submit, along with their application, a signed declaration and all relevant supporting documents and official certificates that clearly justify their condition.

In accordance with the priorities of the Erasmus+ Program, students in any of the following circumstances can be considered from disadvantaged backgrounds.

- 1. Students with a scholarship from the Ministry of Education of their country or equivalent official educational organization.
- 2. Be a large family member, according to the recognition of the country of origin.
- 3. Be a member of a single parent family
- 4. Have a disability more significant than 33% officially recognized in the country of origin or residence.
- 5. Have refugee status in the country of residence.
- 6. Risk of social exclusion or social emergency
- 7. Be an orphan
- 8. Students working full time
